CONDUCTED UNDER THE RULES OF THE PIPING AND DANCING ASSOCIATION OF NEW ZEALAND (INC.)

Rules and Conditions:

1. All events will be conducted under the rules of the Piping & Dancing Association of New Zealand Inc.
2. Entry is via online entry form and payment is to be made by internet banking. In order for entry to be confirmed, payment must be received by the closing date.
3. Competitors compete at their own risk and Ashburton Highland and National Dancing Association (AHND) accepts no responsibility for accidents, mishaps, theft or misplacement of personal property.
4. There will be no refunds if competitors do not compete. However, entry fees will be refunded if the competition is cancelled due to Government restrictions. All other costs incurred by participants (eg travel, accommodation etc) will be at participants own risk.
5. Current PDANZ Registration is compulsory
6. The administration fee of \$60 is compulsory, one per family. Registration includes venue hire, admission, one printed programme per fee, and miscellaneous running costs.
7. AHND reserves the right to alter the order of events if circumstances require this.
8. Events may be danced together at the discretion of the AHND Committee.
9. All presentations will be scheduled at the AHND Committee's discretion.
10. Any person found damaging the theatre property will be liable for full restitution and if they are a competitor, they will forfeit their right to compete.
11. If there are insufficient entries for a CWCC Championship event (5), entries will be taken on the day at no extra charge from competitors already entered in the competition
12. The 4th – 6th prizes for Junior events will only be awarded if there are sufficient entries. For 4th-15 or more entries; 5th - 20 or more entries; 6th – 25 or more entries
13. VHC, HC and C ribbons may be awarded at the discretion of the Adjudicator
14. All New Zealand Championship events will be randomly pre drawn by the Piping and Dancing Executive Committee. Entrants will dance in the order listed in the programme.
15. All other events, including reels, will be pre-drawn by the Competition Secretary. Entrants will dance in the order listed in the programme.
16. New Zealand Championship Competitors must advise their Chaperone if they intend to withdraw from an event.
17. In the event of a tie for a points prize, aggregate marks will be used in accordance with Bylaw 13 of the Piping and Dancing Association of NZ Inc. This includes 1st – 5th Points Prize Sashes in Junior age groups which will be awarded in accordance with Rule 13.
18. Ranking points for all NZ Championship events will be computed as per rule 28.1.2 and 28.1.3.
19. For non-NZ Championship events, a solo dance will be substituted if there are insufficient entries in Reel classes.
20. If you elect not to grant the Piping and Dancing NZ Inc/AHND the right to use your image, it is your responsibility to remove yourself from situations where photos are likely to be taken, such as at presentation times. AHND does not guarantee that your image will not be published as part of a larger group or performance photograph and by participating in the competition or event you automatically waive your rights in respect of such images.
21. All NZ Championship Presentations will be photographed and live-streamed via the Piping and Dancing Association of NZ Inc Facebook page, or other suitable broadcasting platform. Other presentations may be live-streamed and photographed by a representative of AHND.
22. The taking of photos and videos of any performance is strictly prohibited unless prior consent has been granted by AHND.
23. Competitors must report to the Board Steward/Stage Manager immediately when called upon and be ready to dance, or the right to compete in the event may be withdrawn.
24. Prizes are stated in the schedule for each event.
25. Pipers fees are included in the entry fee.
26. Anybody with Covid, influenza, measles or other contagious illness is asked to respect the health and safety of others and not attend the venue.
27. The Junior Competition is intended to take place all day Friday 5th July and finish at lunchtime on Saturday 6th July. This is subject to entries and timings may be altered.
28. The Senior Championship Competition is intended to take place from Saturday 6th July lunchtime and will conclude on Monday, late afternoon. This is subject to entries and timings may be altered.
29. The Senior Opening Ceremony will take place on Saturday 6th July 2024 at approximately 1pm. AHND reserves the right to alter this time after entries close.
30. All competitors required for presentations will be announced by the MC and a numerical list will be posted in the foyer.
31. Complaints procedure: Any protests, concerns or complaints must be notified to Megan Christie in the first instance, for referral to the Complaints Committee.

Senior Registration packs will be available from 6-7.30pm on Friday 5th July, and an opportunity for Senior competitors to try the stage will be made available at the conclusion of Junior events on Friday 5th July.
